There's a new game in town!

We're proud to partner with Prairie Keepers to launch the KFM Power of Produce (POP) Club. Beginning on Saturday, May 13th play the Prairie Keepers Passport Game at KFM. You'll meet farmers, artists and scientists who will have clues to the monthly PK Passport Game Puzzle.

Anyone can play the game, but POP Club membership is reserved for ages 4 - 11. Registration is required. Registered POP Club members will meet at 10:30 by the Keller Town Hall fountain for special presentations on nutrition, local farms and what's in season, wild edibles, how bees and other pollinators make produce possible, and a master chef competition for kids.

Members receive a personalized POP Club Badge, and will earn POP tokens for each passport puzzle solved. Spend your POP tokens at any KFM vendor booth from May 13 through October 28. With each POP token earned, PK Passport Game participants also receive an entry ticket for a grand prize drawn at our October 28 Harvest Festival. See you at the fountain on Saturday, May 13th.
